Hello members; On Sunday we will be holding our Annual General Meeting commencing at 11.00am in the Club Auditorium.

Many of you will have received a copy of the Annual Report and Financial Statements either by way of hard copy or by e-Mail. There will be copies available at Reception or at the Meeting. There is no election this year so your Office bearers will be the same with the exception of two positions. I am pleased to report we have appointed Jason Perica to the Board. We have also filled the other vacancy by promoting Raymond Wildman (who held the next number of votes last elections) to fill the vacant position created by the passing of Noel Mayes. Thus we have finally restored the Board to its eight positions.

The Development Application still rests with the Waverley Council but I can report there have been a number of design alterations requested and they have been taken care of. The program at this stage remains the same with closure expected mid next year and re-opening early in 2021.

We held our March meeting on Wednesday evening after the Design Control Group with Capital Bluestone and one of the main items addressed related to new Audit procedures and the Audit report from W. W. Vick and Co. This was discussed at length and there are no serious issues. Phil Jones our Auditor and Accountant will be attending the meeting this Sunday and will update the members on any changes.

We are also in the process of looking for alternative accommodation for our members when the Club closes and things are very positive at present. I will keep you informed.

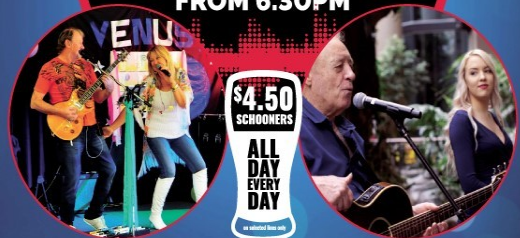
